

# Alpine Children's Team Review – Terms of Reference



## 1. Introduction

The BSS board has decided to carry out a full review and consultation about the British Children's U14 and U16 Alpine Ski Team. The Board has asked Tim Fawke to conduct this review. The main drivers of this review are:

- The end of the Roger De Haan funding for the Children's Team
- The new vision and objectives the BSS board has set out and the resources it has available
- Specific concerns that have been raised by coaches, clubs, academies and parents regarding the Children's Team

The BSS Board has asked for a draft report by July. The final report and it's recommendations will be available to all those consulted and will be published on the BSS website.

## 2. Terms of Reference

To get feedback from all stakeholders regarding the current structure of U16 and U14 programme delivered by BSS and look at possible options for future seasons (starting 14/15 season) that fit best with BSS vision and objectives for the organisation and the goals of the Children's ski teams.

This report will initially be presented back to the BSS Board and BSS Alpine committee
